

## *Testing Day Etiquette*

- 1. Parents are responsible for their children. Please keep all children (testing and not testing) with you and quiet so others can concentrate and to show respect for fellow testers.*
- 2. The side room is for testing practice only. Only students preparing for testing are permitted in the side room.*
- 3. Formal testing uniforms are required. Yellow belts and higher must have the 3 main patches sewn on uniform.*
- 4. White, black or grey shirts (no collar) should be worn under the jacket. As always, shirts are to be tucked into pants.*
- 5. No jewelry.*
- 6. Hair should be tied back and off the face – this applies to boys as well as girls.*
- 7. Students will be bowed in together and dismissed at the end of testing together. When your personal testing is over, you are free to leave, however, we encourage you to stay and support your fellow students.*
- 8. Please do not cross the mats when students are testing.*
- 9. NO FORMS OR FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF TESTING.*
